RESOLVE INCREASING THE SCOPE OF THE INVESTIGATION  
AND STUDY BY THE SPECIAL COMMISSION ON TAXATION.

1 *Resolved*, That the unpaid special commission, known  
2 as the special commission on taxation, established by  
3 chapter eighty-six of the resolves of nineteen hundred  
4 and forty-eight, and most recently continued by chapter  
5 thirty-two of the resolves of the current year, shall, in  
6 making its investigation and study, consider the sub-  
7 ject matter proposed by current house document num-  
8 bered 2780.
