The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Five.

AN ACT TRANSFERRING TO THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION THE CARE, CONTROL AND MAINTENANCE OF CERTAIN PORTIONS OF COLUMBIA ROAD IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission is
2 hereby authorized and directed to take over the care,
3 control and maintenance of that portion of Columbia
4 road beginning at Kosciusco circle in the Dorchester dis-
5 trict of the city of Boston and running northerly to the
6 traffic circle at the junction of Preble street and Old
7 Colony avenue in the South Boston district of said city,
8 that portion of Old Colony avenue which lies between
9 said Kosciusco circle and said traffic circle, and that
10 portion of Columbia road adjacent to Columbus park
11 and running easterly from said traffic circle at Preble
12 street to William J. Day Boulevard.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its accept-
2 ance by vote of the city council of the city of Boston,
3 pursuant to the provisions of its charter, but not other-
4 wise.
