Ordered, That the joint committee on Ways and Means is hereby authorized to make an investigation and study of the subject matter of current Senate document numbered 232 increasing State aid for schools. Said committee may travel within and without the Commonwealth and may expend for expert, clerical and other assistance and for expenses such sums as may be appropriated therefor. Said committee shall report to the General Court the results of its study and its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of legislation necessary to carry its recommendations into effect, by filing the same with the Clerk of the Senate on or before the first Wednesday in December of the current year.
