AN ACT RELATIVE TO MEDICAL EXAMINATIONS OF PRESENT OR PROSPECTIVE EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 159B of chapter 149 of the General Laws,
2 inserted by chapter 241 of the acts of 1949, is hereby
3 amended by inserting at the end thereof, the follow-
4 ing: — , and any employee so examined may at the ter-
5 mination of his employment request of his employer
6 another physical examination, said examination to be
7 made by an impartial doctor agreeable to both employee
8 and employer.
