AN ACT PERMITTING CERTAIN LICENSEES TO SERVE ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES AT BARS OR COUNTERS ON SUNDAYS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The second paragraph of section 12 of
2 chapter 138, as most recently amended by section 4 of
3 chapter 542 of the acts of 1943, is hereby further amended
4 by striking out all after the word "stools" in line 5.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall apply only to clubs.
