AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE POWERS OF DEVELOPMENT AND INDUSTRIAL COMMISSIONS ESTABLISHED IN CERTAIN CITIES AND TOWNS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 Section 8A of chapter 40 of the General Laws, inserted
- 2 by section 1 of chapter 297 of the acts of 1954, is hereby
- 3 amended by adding at the end the following paragraph:—
- 4 Such commission may construct and locate railroad
- 5 tracks with municipal funds in cases where the railroad
- 6 is unwilling to finance the cost of such work.
