AN ACT RELATIVE TO MAKE-UP PAYMENTS IN THE CONTRIBUTORY RETIREMENT SYSTEM.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Paragraph (d) of subdivision (6) of section 3 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, as amended, 2 is hereby further amended by adding at the end the following sentence: — Any surviving beneficiary of a former 3 member of the general court who is otherwise eligible to 4 receive the benefits provided by chapter five hundred and 5 fifty-four of the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-five, 6 who has withdrawn the contributions and accumulated 7 total deductions paid into the state retirement fund by 8 such member, as provided by chapter six hundred and 9 fifteen of the acts of nineteen hundred and fifty-four, 10 shall, upon payment into said fund, in one sum, of the 11 amount so withdrawn with interest, be eligible for the 12 benefits provided by said chapter five hundred and fifty- 13 four.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage 2 and shall apply only to those beneficiaries who comply 3 with the provisions of section one thereof prior to January 4 first, nineteen hundred and fifty-six.
