### RESOLVE IN FAVOR OF PETER AND DOLORES SANZANO OF NEW BEDFORD.

1 *Resolved*, That, for the purpose of discharging a moral  
2 obligation of the commonwealth, and after an appro-  
3 priation has been made therefor, there be allowed and  
4 paid out of the treasury of the commonwealth to Peter  
5 Sanzano of New Bedford the sum of three hundred and  
6 thirteen dollars and seven cents, and to his wife Dolores  
7 Sanzano the sum of one thousand dollars to compensate  
8 them for property damages and personal injuries, re-  
9 spectively, sustained by them as a result of a motor  
10 vehicle accident at a culvert adjacent to Route 2 in the  
11 town of Erving. No payment shall be made hereunder  
12 until there shall have been filed with the comptroller an  
13 agreement signed by the said Peter and Dolores Sanzano  
14 that the amount, if any, paid or to be paid for legal  
15 services rendered in connection with the passage of this  
16 resolve shall not exceed ten per cent of the amounts to  
17 be paid hereunder.
