## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Six.

### AN ACT RELATIVE TO REIMBURSEMENT TO CITIES AND TOWNS FOR CERTAIN EXPENSES INCURRED IN TRANSPORTATION OF PUPILS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 7A of chapter 71 of the General Laws, inserted  
2 by section 1 of chapter 679 of the acts of 1947, as amended  
3 by chapter 754 of the acts of 1949, is hereby further  
4 amended by striking out the first nine lines as appearing  
5 in said section 1 of chapter 679 of 1947 and inserting  
6 therefor immediately preceding the word "provided",  
7 the following:— The state treasurer shall annually, on  
8 or before November twentieth, reimburse all cities and  
9 towns providing transportation for pupils, to the full  
10 extent of the amounts expended for such transportation.
