AN ACT REPEALING THE PROVISIONS OF LAW RELATING TO THE TOWING OR REMOVAL OF CERTAIN MOTOR VEHICLES BY POLICE IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 263 of the acts of
2 1929 is hereby amended by striking out the fourth sen-
3 tence, as amended by chapter 315 of the acts of 1955.

1 SECTION 2. Said section 2 of said chapter 263 is
2 hereby further amended by striking out the fifth sen-
3 tence, as appearing in section 1 of chapter 369 of the
4 acts of 1954.
