AN ACT PLACING THE INCUMBENT OF THE POSITION OF LABOR
MANAGEMENT AGENT OF THE PORT OF BOSTON COMMISSION
UNDER THE CIVIL SERVICE LAWS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,
as follows:*

1 The position of labor management agent of the port
2 of Boston commission shall, upon the effective date of
3 this act, become subject to the civil service laws and
4 rules, and the tenure of office of the incumbent thereof
5 on January first, nineteen hundred and fifty-five, shall
6 be unlimited, subject, however, to said laws and rules;
7 provided, that he passes a qualifying examination to be
8 given by the division of civil service. Upon passing said
9 examination, he shall be deemed to be permanently ap-
10 pointed to said position without being required to serve
11 any probationary period.
