AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TRAFFIC COMMISSION IN THE CITY OF MALDEN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 67 of the acts of 1947 is hereby
2 amended by striking out section 2 and inserting in
3 place thereof the following section:—

4 *Section 2.* The captain of police, or his representa-
5 tive, shall act as the chairman of said commission and
6 shall be known as the traffic commissioner. The members
7 and secretary of the commission shall receive such com-
8 pensation for their services as may be fixed by the city
9 council, the same to be paid from the receipts from
10 parking meters. All statutes and ordinances applicable
11 generally to the departments of the city shall apply
12 to the commission.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
