AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ADJUSTMENT OF THE MILEAGE ALLOWANCE FOR STATE EMPLOYEES OPERATING THEIR OWN AUTOMOBILES ON OFFICIAL BUSINESS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The allowance to state employees for expenses in-
- 2 curred by them in the operation of motor vehicles owned
- 3 by them and used in the performance of their official
- 4 duties shall not exceed ten cents per mile.
