By Messrs. Hannon of Boston and Condon of Boston, petition of Thomas J. Hannon and James F. Condon that the Registrar of Motor Vehicles be prohibited from recording demerit points on licenses to operate motor vehicles. Insurance.

AN ACT TO PROHIBIT THE RECORDING OF POINTS ON A LICENSE TO OPERATE A MOTOR VEHICLE.

1 *Whereas*, The deferred operation of this act would
2 tend to defeat its purpose, which is to prohibit immed-
3 iately the recording of points charged on a license to
4 operate a motor vehicle, therefore it is hereby declared
5 to be an emergency law, necessary for the immediate
6 preservation of the public convenience.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Chapter 90A, inserted by section 1 of
2 chapter 570 of the acts of 1953, is hereby amended by
3 striking out section 11 and inserting in place thereof the
4 following section:—

5 *Section 11.* No record of points charged shall be re-
6 corded on any license to operate a motor vehicle.

1 SECTION 2. The registrar shall issue a new license
2 without charge to replace any license upon which points
3 have been recorded prior to the effective date of this act.
