AN ACT FURTHER TO ADJUST THE SALARIES OF STATE AND MUNICIPAL EMPLOYEES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 46 of chapter 30 of the General Laws, as
2 most recently amended by chapter 715 of the acts of
3 1951, is hereby further amended by adding after sub-
4 division 10 the following new subdivision:—

5 11. Notwithstanding any of the provisions of section
6 forty-five and of this section, any employee in the classi-
7 fied service or who occupies any position which is subject
8 to the provisions of said sections, whose regularly as-
9 signed hours of duty are more than half between six
10 postmeridian and six antemeridian, shall be paid a salary
11 rate in the salary grade schedule based on the provisions
12 of this section, plus an additional ten cents per hour.
