AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE GRANTING OF AID TO DEPENDENT CHILDREN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 2 of chapter 118 of the General
2 Laws, as amended, is hereby further amended by add-
3 ing at the end thereof the following paragraph:—

4 Each local board of public welfare shall include in the
5 budget of each recipient an item, to be known as “Recre-
6 ational Activities”, under which there shall be paid to
7 each such recipient, in addition to any other sum paid to
8 him, the sum of three dollars monthly. Cities and towns
9 making payments under this paragraph shall be re-
10 imbursed by the commonwealth to the full amount
11 thereof, notwithstanding any other provision of law.

1 SECTION 2. Payments for recreational activities un-
2 der the provisions of this act shall be appropriated from
3 the additional three dollar increase for aid to dependent
4 children now being paid by the federal government to
5 the commonwealth.
