AN ACT RELATIVE TO PARKING OF MOTOR VEHICLES ON STREETS AND WAYS IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 2 of chapter 263 of the acts of 1929, as most
2 recently amended by section 1 of chapter 366 of the
3 acts of 1952, is hereby further amended by adding at
4 the end of said section the following paragraph:—

5 The provisions of this section shall be administered
6 by the traffic commission of the city of Boston. Upon
7 the petition of twenty-five registered voters of the city
8 relative to the designating of certain ways, streets or
9 highways as all-night parking places, the said commis-
10 sioners shall hold a public hearing thereon within thirty
11 days after the filing with said commissioners of such
12 petition, and final action thereon shall be determined
13 only by vote of a majority of said commissioners. Ac-
14 tion by the commission must be taken within thirty
15 days and notice thereof sent to each of the petitioners.
