## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Six.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO CONSTRUCT A RECREATIONAL AREA IN THE CITY OF SOMERVILLE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission  
2 is hereby authorized to construct and maintain in the  
3 city of Somerville, in the vicinity or Dilboy field, a rec-  
4 reational area consisting of tennis courts, a hand-ball  
5 court, little league and regular baseball diamonds,  
6 basketball courts and a skating rink.

1 SECTION 2. The metropolitan district commission  
2 may expend the sum of two hundred thousand dollars  
3 for such construction.
