### AN ACT PROVIDING A SALARY FOR DEPUTY CONSERVATION OFFICERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 6 of chapter 21 of the General Laws, as ap-  
2 pearing in section 1 of chapter 631 of the acts of 1953,  
3 is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the  
4 following sentence: — Deputy conservation officers ap-  
5 pointed by the director shall receive such salary as the  
6 board may determine.
