AN ACT PROVIDING THAT MARCH SEVENTEENTH SHALL BE A
LEGAL HOLIDAY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 7 of chapter 4 of the General Laws, as amended,
2 is hereby further amended by inserting in clause Eight-
3 eenth, as most recently amended by chapter 241 of the
4 acts of 1948, immediately after the words "February
5 twenty-second" and immediately before the words
6 "April nineteenth," the words:— March seventeenth.
