RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR A STUDY INTO THE ADVISABILITY OF CONSTRUCTING AN AERIAL HIGHWAY IN THE CITY OF LAWRENCE.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to con-
2 sist of two members of the senate to be designated by the
3 president thereof, three members of the house of repre-
4 sentatives to be designated by the speaker thereof, and
5 three persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby
6 established for the purpose of making a study into the
7 advisability of constructing an aerial highway in the
8 city of Lawrence. Said commission may expend for
9 clerical and other services and expenses such sums as
10 may be appropriated therefor. Said commission shall
11 report to the general court the results of its study, and
12 its recommendations, if any, together with drafts of
13 legislation necessary to carry its recommendations into
14 effect, by filing the same with the clerk of the house of
15 representatives on or before the first Wednesday in
16 December in the year nineteen hundred and fifty-six.
