RESOLVE PROVIDING THE REPRESENTATION OF THE COMMONWEALTH AT THE NATIONAL CONVENTION OF THE SOCIETY OF THE FIRST DIVISION TO BE HELD IN THE CITY OF BOSTON IN THE YEAR 1956.

1 *Resolved*, That in order that the commonwealth may
2 be properly represented on the occasion of the National
3 Convention of the Society of the First Division to be held
4 in the city of Boston on August twenty-fourth, twenty-
5 fifth and twenty-sixth, inclusive, in the current year,
6 and to ensure, in arranging entertainments and other
7 events in connection therewith between the Society of
8 the First Division and the commonwealth, there may be
9 expended, with the approval and under the direction of
10 the governor and council, for said purpose such sums as
11 may be appropriated therefor.
