AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE TRANSFER OF MONEYS FROM THE
PARKING METERS ACCOUNT TO PAY FOR TRAFFIC LIGHTS

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,
as follows:*

4 sary to pay for the cost of installation and maintenance
5 of traffic lights installed in said city during the years
6 nineteen hundred and fifty-four and nineteen hundred
7 and fifty-five.
