AN ACT TO FURTHER CHANGE THE OVERTIME REGULATIONS  
FOR CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,  
as follows:*

1 Section 30A of chapter 149 of the General Laws, as  
2 amended by chapter 626 of the acts of 1952, is hereby  
3 amended by striking out, in the last two lines, the  
4 words "in accordance with the pertinent rule or rules  
5 of the commission on administration and finance" and  
6 inserting in place thereof the words:— at the rate of  
7 time and one half.

As amended by the Senate and House of Representatives  
 of the Commonwealth, and by the authority of the  
 several Courts, and as follows:

1. Section III of Chapter 148 of the General Laws, as amended by Chapter 230 of the Acts of 1921, is hereby amended by striking out in the first two lines the words "in connection with the position and title" and
2. in the connection of "of reputation and honor" and
3. inserting in place thereof the words "in the city or town and one half."
