AN ACT RELATIVE TO THE RATE OF COMPENSATION PAID TO SPECIAL POLICE OFFICERS BY CONTRACTORS ON CHAPTER NINETY HIGHWAY PROJECTS, SO CALLED.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by inserting after section 34C the following section: —
3 *Section 34D.* Every contract for the maintenance,
4 repair, improvement or construction of town and county
5 highways under the provisions of paragraph (a) of sub-
6 division (2) of section thirty-four of chapter ninety shall
7 contain stipulations requiring that the contractor shall
8 pay to any special police officer employed by him at a
9 rate of wage of not less than one dollar and fifty cents
10 per hour, or such other higher rate of wage as may be
11 determined from time to time by the state department
12 of labor and industries.
