*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 Chapter 59 of the General Laws, section 5, clause 20,
2 as most recently amended by chapter 347 of the acts
3 of 1953, is hereby further amended by striking out the
4 words "farming utensils" and inserting in place thereof
5 the following: — farm tools, equipment and machinery,
6 other than motor vehicles and trailers upon which a
7 motor vehicle or trailer excise is payable.
