AN ACT REQUIRING EMPLOYERS AND THE DIVISION OF INDUSTRIAL ACCIDENTS TO PROVIDE TO EMPLOYEES INJURED IN THE COURSE OF THEIR EMPLOYMENT COPIES OF ALL REPORTS AND CORRESPONDENCE PERTAINING TO SAID INJURY.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 19 of chapter 152 of the General Laws, as  
2 amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the  
3 end thereof the following new paragraph:—  
4 Copies of reports of injuries filed by employers with  
5 the division, and copies of all communications from  
6 employers to the division shall be furnished to each in-  
7 jured employee. The division shall also furnish each  
8 said injured employee with a copy of every communica-  
9 tion relative to the injury of said employee forwarded  
10 to his employer.
