AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO IMPROVE THE SAUGUS RIVER ADJACENT TO THE OLD IRON WORKS IN SAUGUS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 The metropolitan district commission is hereby au-
