AN ACT GRANTING ANNUITIES TO THE SURVIVING SPOUSE OR CHILDREN OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF CITIES AND TOWNS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 95 of chapter 32 of the General Laws, inserted
2 by chapter 387 of the acts of 1953, is hereby amended by
3 adding at the end thereof the following sentence:— The
4 provisions of this section shall apply to the surviving
5 spouse of an employee who at the time of his decease
6 was a member of the non-contributory retirement sys-
7 tem so long as such spouse survives and does not remarry,
8 or, if there is no surviving spouse, to a legal guardian for
9 the benefit of any surviving child who is unmarried and
10 under the age of eighteen, and the surviving spouse or
11 child is not entitled to a pension under any other section
12 of the General Laws.
