AN ACT CONCERNING THE PUNISHMENT OF VIOLATIONS OF CERTAIN RULES, ORDERS AND REGULATIONS OF THE BOARD OF FIRE PREVENTION REGULATIONS, THE FIRE MARSHAL AND THE HEADS OF FIRE DEPARTMENTS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 30 of chapter 148 of the General Laws, as most
2 recently amended by section 13 of chapter 710 of the
3 acts of 1945, is hereby further amended by striking out
4 the first sentence and inserting in place thereof the
5 following sentence: — Violation of any lawful rule,
6 order or regulation of the board or of any lawful order
7 of the marshal or rule or order of the head of a fire de-
8 partment, punishment whereof is not otherwise provided
9 for, shall be punished by a fine of not more than ten
10 dollars for each day during which such violation con-
11 tinues after notice of the regulation, rule or order.
