## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PAYMENT FOR THE ACCUMULATED SICK LEAVE OF CERTAIN EMPLOYEES OF CITIES AND TOWNS UPON THE DEATH OF SUCH EMPLOYEE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 111E of chapter 41 of the General Laws, as  
2 most recently amended by chapter 13 of the acts of  
3 1954, is hereby further amended by inserting after the  
4 first sentence, as appearing in chapter 436 of the acts  
5 of 1953 the following new sentence:— Whenever the  
6 employment of any such person who has accumulated  
7 sick leave under the provisions of section one hundred  
8 and thirteen B is terminated by death his estate shall  
9 be paid at the regular rate of compensation for the  
10 amount of sick leave so accumulated.
