By Mr. Wall of Lawrence, petition of Samuel B. Horovitz for legislation relative to permanent and partial incapacity payments to seriously injured industrial workers. Labor and Industries.

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Six.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR PERMANENT AND PARTIAL INCAPACITY PAYMENTS FOR SERIOUSLY INJURED INDUSTRIAL WORKERS, AND TO ENCOURAGE THEIR REHABILITATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 Chapter 152 of the General Laws is hereby amended
- 2 by adding at the end of section 34A the following: —
- 3 Where an employee has received a permanent and
- 4 serious injury resulting in the payment of specific com-
- 5 pensation under part or parts of section thirty-six equal
- 6 to or in excess of ninety-nine weeks, and the incapacity
- 7 resulting is both permanent and partial but not total,
- 8 he shall receive ten dollars a week for life, regardless of
- 9 his earnings thereafter.
