AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN FEES TO BE CHARGED BY THE LAND COURT AND REGISTRIES OF DEEDS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 262 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by striking out the second paragraph of section 38, as
3 most recently amended by chapter 348 of the acts of
4 1953, and inserting in place thereof the following para-
5 graph:—

6 For all copies except photographic copies, at the rate
7 of sixty cents a legal page of two hundred and twenty-
8 four words. For photographic copies of all instruments,
9 except copies of plans, at rates to be determined by the
10 register, but not to exceed forty cents a page.
