### AN ACT RELATIVE TO APPOINTMENT OF ACTING COUNTY COMMISSIONERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 144 of chapter 54 of the General Laws is  
2 hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the fol-  
3 lowing: — The person so appointed shall be a member  
4 of the same political party as that of the county com-  
5 missioner in whose position he is acting county commis-
