AN ACT TO PROVIDE THAT CITY VOTING PRECINCTS SHALL  
CONTAIN NOT MORE THAN FIFTEEN HUNDRED VOTERS.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in  
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same,  
as follows:*

1 Section 2 of chapter 54 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out the words "two thousand"  
3 wherever they occur, and substituting therefore the  
4 words: — fifteen hundred.
