The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

In the Year One Thousand Nine Hundred and Fifty-Six.

AN ACT AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE METROPOLITAN DISTRICT COMMISSION TO CONSTRUCT AND MAINTAIN AN OUTDOOR SWIMMING POOL, AN OUTDOOR WADING POOL, DRESSING ROOMS AND A RECREATIONAL AREA AT MISSION HILL PLAYGROUND IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The metropolitan district commission is
2 hereby authorized and directed to construct and main-
3 tain an outdoor swimming pool, an outdoor wading pool,
4 dressing rooms and a recreational area at Mission Hill
5 playground located at Tremont street, Roxbury, in the
6 city of Boston. For said purposes, said commission may
7 expend such sums as may be appropriated therefor.

1 SECTION 2. For the purposes of this act, the commis-
2 sion may take in the name of the commonwealth, in fee
3 or otherwise, under chapter seventy-nine of the General
4 Laws, or may acquire by purchase, gift or otherwise,
5 such public buildings and land, including park land, in
6 the city of Boston, as may be necessary.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.

By the order of the House, the following resolution was adopted: That the Committee on the Administration of the Government be authorized to inquire into the conduct of the various departments of the Government, and to report thereon to the House at such time as it may be ordered.

THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE COMMONWEALTH

In the Year of the Nineteenth of the Commonwealth, 1854.

AN ACT TO AUTHORIZE THE COMMISSIONERS OF THE COMMONWEALTH TO TAKE THE NECESSARY STEPS FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF THE CITY OF BOSTON, AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW WATER WORKS, AND FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A NEW BRIDGE OVER THE RIVER IN THE CITY OF BOSTON.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

SECTION 1. The Commissioners of the Commonwealth be and they are authorized and directed to construct and maintain an outdoor swimming pool, an outdoor water park, a dressing room and a recreational area at Boston Hill, a playground located at Tremont street, Boston, in the city of Boston, for said purposes, said commission may expend such sums as may be appropriated therefor.

SECTION 2. For the purpose of this act, the commission may take in the name of the Commonwealth, in fee, or otherwise, under chapter seven, section of the General Laws, or may acquire by purchase, gift or otherwise, such public buildings and land, including park land, in the city of Boston, as may be necessary.

SECTION 3. This act shall take effect upon its passage.
