AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE COMMONWEALTH TO REIMBURSE THE CITIES AND TOWNS OF THE METROPOLITAN PARKS DISTRICT FOR SUMS CHARGED TO THEM IN CONNECTION WITH THE NANTASKET BEACH RESERVATION, THE REVERE BEACH RESERVATION AND THE LYNN-NAHANT BEACH RESERVATION.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 92 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by inserting after section 59A the following section: —
3 *Section 59B.* On November twentieth in each year
4 the commonwealth shall pay out of the General Fund to
5 each city and town in the metropolitan parks district a
6 sum equal to the amount payable on such date by such
7 city or town under section fifty-eight in connection with
8 the Nantasket beach reservation, the Lynn-Nahant
9 beach reservation, and the Revere beach reservation.
