AN ACT RELATIVE TO ALLOWANCES TO CITIES AND TOWNS FOR ARMORIES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 33 of the General Laws, as most recently
2 amended by chapter 590 of the acts of 1954, is hereby
3 further amended by striking out section 118 and insert-
4 ing in place thereof the following section: —
5 *Section 118.* For each armory, air installation or ade-
6 quate facility maintained by a city or town, or privately
7 owned, the commonwealth shall reimburse the city or
8 town a sum or sums equal to the amounts paid for rentals
9 and for all charges of maintenance, including light and
10 fuel, for such armory.
