*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

- 1 All decisions regarding the personnel of the common-

- 3 and standardization or the commission on administration
- 4 and finance, may be appealed to the governor and council
- 5 for final determination.
