## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT TO PERMIT THE REFUND TO COMPAGNIE NATIONALE AIR FRANCE, COMMONLY CALLED AIR FRANCE, OF CERTAIN GASOLINE TAXES PAID ON GASOLINE USED AS FUEL FOR AIRPLANES IN TRANSATLANTIC SERVICE.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The right to reimbursement, in accordance with the  
2 provisions of section seven of chapter sixty-four A of  
3 the General Laws, as amended, for gasoline taxes on  
4 fuel purchased from the period of April fourteenth, nine-  
5 teen hundred and forty-eight, through October seven-  
6 teenth, nineteen hundred and forty-nine, both dates in-  
7 clusive, by Compagnie Nationale Air France, commonly  
8 called Air France, is hereby granted to said corporation,  
9 upon filing by it of the customary non-highway use re-  
10 fund application within six months of the effective date  
11 of this act.
