## The Commonwealth of Massachusetts

AN ACT AUTHORIZING THE COMMISSIONER OF THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION TO PURCHASE AND RENOVATE THE EMERTON ESTATE, SO CALLED, IN THE CITY OF SALEM FOR THE BENEFIT OF THE STATE TEACHERS COLLEGE AT SALEM.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 The commissioner of the department of education is  
2 hereby authorized and directed to purchase, and upon  
3 purchasing to renovate, the Emerton Estate, so called,  
4 located in the city of Salem, for the use and benefit of  
5 the state teachers college at Salem which abuts said  
6 Emerton Estate on the northerly side; provided, how-  
7 ever, that said commissioner shall be under no duty to so  
8 purchase and renovate unless and until an appropriation  
9 of the sum of forty thousand dollars is made by the  
10 general court for such purposes.

The bill of the Senate passed on 17th April 1871. The House of Representatives passed it on 21st April 1871. The bill was signed by the President on 23rd April 1871.

AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION OF THE BUSINESS OF THE COMMONWEALTH IN THE CITY OF BOSTON, AND TO AMEND AN ACT IN THAT BEARING THE TITLE OF AN ACT TO PROVIDE FOR THE REGULATION OF THE BUSINESS OF THE COMMONWEALTH IN THE CITY OF BOSTON, PASSED IN THE YEAR ONE THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED AND FORTY EIGHT.

Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same as follows:

1. The commissioners of the department of agriculture
2. hereby authorized and directed to purchase and
3. purchase to wit: the Boston Herald, a paper
4. printed in the city of Boston for the year and month of
5. the state treasury shall be paid which shall be
6. printed in the city of Boston for the year and month of
7. year, and said commission shall be paid to the
8. purchase and conveyance and until an appropriation
9. of the sum of five thousand dollars is made for the
10. general fund for such purpose.
