RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO PREMIUM CHARGES USED AND CHARGED BY INSURANCE COMPANIES FOR ALL FORMS OF MOTOR VEHICLE INSURANCE.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to con-  
2 sist of one member of the senate to be designated by the  
3 president thereof, three members of the house of repre-  
4 sentatives to be designated by the speaker thereof, and  
5 three persons to be appointed by the governor, is hereby  
6 established for the purpose of making an investigation  
7 relative to premium charges used and charged by insur-  
8 ance companies for all forms of insurance written in con-  
9 nection with motor vehicles, with a view to determine  
10 to what extent such charges may be excessive or unfairly  
11 discriminatory or otherwise, and to determine what legis-  
12 lation, if any, may be necessary to further regulate such  
13 premium charges.
