AN ACT RELATIVE TO PROVIDING UNIFORMS FOR COURT OFFICERS IN THE DISTRICT COURTS OF THE COMMONWEALTH.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 Section 63 of chapter 218 of the General Laws is hereby  
2 amended by striking out, in line 1 thereof, the words  
3 "Suffolk County" and inserting in place thereof the  
4 words:— the commonwealth,— and by striking out,  
5 in line 3 thereof, the words "said county" and inserting  
6 in place thereof the words:— the county in which said  
7 court shall be located.
