AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE ELIMINATION OF PREMIUM SURCHARGES IN CERTAIN CASES.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Section 15 of chapter 90A of the General Laws, inserted
2 by section 1 of chapter 570 of the acts of 1953, is hereby
3 amended by inserting after the first sentence the follow-
4 ing sentence:— The schedule of surcharges shall not
5 provide for any premium surcharges when the number of
6 points charged against the owner is less than thirteen.
