AN ACT PROVIDING FOR TRANSPORTATION OF DECEASED STATE EMPLOYEES WHO DIE WHILE AWAY FROM HOME ON STATE BUSINESS.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Chapter 30 of the General Laws is hereby amended
2 by inserting after section 25, the following section: —
3 *Section 25A.* All state officers and employees, eligible
4 under the provisions of section twenty-five of this act,
5 to be reimbursed for reasonable expenses incurred while
6 traveling in the performance of their duties, shall be
7 transported to their homes in the event of their death
8 while performing said duties away from their homes, at
9 the expense of the commonwealth.
