AN ACT RELATIVE TO CERTAIN IMPROVEMENTS TO BE EFFECTED IN THE DORCHESTER DISTRICT OF BOSTON.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The city of Boston is hereby authorized  
2 and directed to modernize a section of the Girl's Latin  
3 High School, located in the Codman square district of  
4 Dorchester in the city of Boston and equip the same to  
5 function as a health unit. This unit shall be equipped  
6 with the instruments necessary for physiotherapy treat-  
7 ment, chest X-rays, post-natal infant care, first aid  
8 treatment and all other emergencies. This health unit  
9 station is to be maintained on a twenty-four hour daily  
10 basis.

1 SECTION 2. The city of Boston is hereby authorized  
2 and directed to remove all existing gas street lighting in  
3 ward seventeen of the Dorchester district of Boston and  
4 replace the same with modern electric lighting.

1 SECTION 3. For the purposes of this act, the city of  
2 Boston may expend such sums as may be appropriated  
3 therefor.
