AN ACT RELATIVE TO EDUCATIONAL CERTIFICATES ISSUED TO MINORS BETWEEN SIXTEEN AND EIGHTEEN YEARS OF AGE.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Section 95 of chapter 149 of the General
2 Laws is hereby amended by striking out the word
3 "twenty-one" as appearing in line 2 of section 9 of
4 chapter 133 of the acts of 1945, and inserting in place
5 thereof the word: — eighteen.

1 SECTION 2. The second paragraph of said section
2 95 of chapter 149 of the General Laws is hereby amended
3 by striking out the word "twenty-one" as appearing
4 in lines 22 and 23 of the Tercentenary Edition, and
5 inserting in place thereof the word: — eighteen.
