RESOLVE PROVIDING FOR AN INVESTIGATION AND STUDY BY A SPECIAL COMMISSION RELATIVE TO AWARDING STATE SCHOLARSHIPS TO CERTAIN STUDENTS.

1 *Resolved*, That an unpaid special commission, to con-
2 sist of five members designated by the governor, is
3 hereby established for the purpose of making an in-
4 vestigation and study relative to awarding fifty state
5 scholarships to worthy and deserving students of the
6 commonwealth. Said commission may expend such sums
7 as may be appropriated therefor. Said commission shall
8 report to the general court the results of its investiga-
9 tion and study, and its recommendations, if any, together
10 with drafts of legislation necessary to carry such recom-
11 mendations into effect, by filing the same with the clerk
12 of the house of representatives not later than the first
13 Wednesday of December in the current year.
