By Mr. Ruether of Williamstown, petition of Richard A. Ruether that the Department of Public Works be authorized to dredge a part of Hemlock Brook in the town of Williamstown. Harbors and Public Lands.

AN ACT PROVIDING FOR THE DREDGING OF A CERTAIN PART OF THE HEMLOCK BROOK IN THE TOWN OF WILLIAMSTOWN.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 The department of public works is hereby authorized
2 and directed to dredge the Hemlock brook in the town of
3 Williamstown from the bridge on Glynn street opposite
4 the state highway yard in the Dean's lot to the end of
5 the property at Taconic park. For said purposes said
6 department may expend, subject to appropriation, the
7 sum of dollars, together with the sum of
8 dollars to be provided by the town of
9 Williamstown. No work shall be begun until said town
10 has deposited in the state treasury the sum of
11 dollars for the purposes herein set forth.
