AN ACT PROVIDING THAT THE PROVISIONS OF LAW ESTABLISHING CONTRIBUTORY GROUP LIFE, ACCIDENT, HOSPITALIZATION, MEDICAL AND SURGICAL INSURANCE FOR PERSONS IN THE SERVICE OF THE COMMONWEALTH SHALL APPLY TO MEMBERS OF THE JUDICIARY.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 Subsection (b) of section 2 of chapter 32A of the
2 General Laws is hereby amended by striking out the
3 second sentence and inserting in place thereof the
4 following sentence:—By way of illustration but not
5 limitation, a person appointed or elected by popular
6 vote shall include employees of the general court, state
7 officials, constitutional officers, members of the general
8 court and members of the judiciary, but shall in no
9 event be construed to include seasonal employees or
10 emergency employees.
